WHAT IS THE ERASMUS+ STAFF MOBILITY?

Erasmus+ is the exchange program of the European Union (EU) and the largest exchange program worldwide. Under the KA171 project line, the EU provides funding not only for students from outside the EU to study at an European university but also for employees of universities in our partner countries.

The University of Hohenheim has successfully applied for an Erasmus+ project with the partner country **South Africa**. As a result, the Erasmus+ grant covers individual grants for Staff- and / or Student Mobilities between the University of Hohenheim and institutions in the partner coountry South Africa.

ERASMUS+ FUNDING

Erasmus+ funding supports for stays at the University of Hohenheim from a **minimum of 5 to a maximum of 60 days** under the Erasmus+ program with partner countries.

The amount of support is staggered as follows:

Amount up to and including 14th funding day of stay: **160 EUR/day**Amount from the 15th funding day of stay: **112 EUR/day**

In addition, participants will receive a grant for **travel allowance** based on one-way distance between the home university and the University of Hohenheim (determinded by the EU Commission calculator). For the distance of more than 8000 km the **travel allowance is 1.500 EUR**.

The exact amount of funding depends on the available budget as well as the exact dates of stay and possible special funding.
